OSC 454 – Apologies

Cllr L. Turner proposed apologies be accepted from Cllr Munby, Seconded Cllr Kelly, All in favour

OSC 455 – Declarations of Interest

(i) There were no declarations of interest

OSC 456 – Cemetery

(i) The Committee considered the registration of Cemetery Land and requested Clerk make contact with the diocese of York in order to obtain copies of the original documentation detailing the Church formally handing the Churchyard to the Parish Council. Proposed Cllr L. Turner, Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

(ii) The Committee reviewed the current cemetery fees. Cllr Barnett proposed the Internment of cremated remains in a existing grave be increased to £315.00 with immediate effect . Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour. Cllr M, Turner proposed non- resident fees be increased - Grant of Exclusive Right burial £742.00, Grant of Exclusive Right Garden of remembrance £592.00 Internment of a coffin containing a person whose age at death exceeded 16 years £816.00, Seconded Cllr Barnett, all in favour. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Committee consider fees for Exhumation at the discretion of the Parish Council upon receipt of an exhumation enquiry. Seconded Cllr Barnett, all in favour

(v)The Committee considered a budget for installation of protective mesh to Cherry trees and requested Clerk make arrangements for the installation providing the amount should not exceed £250.00. Proposed Cllr Barnett, Seconded Cllr L. Turner, All in favour.

OSC 457 – Playpark

(i)The Committee received a update relating to the tree application for Playpark area. The Sports and Recreation have the matter in hand with the ERYC and a application should be submitted shortly.

OSC 458– King Georges Field

(i)The Committee considered the wren application for additional equipment within King Georges Playing Field. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Clerk obtain plans and pricing for the installation of picnic Benches, Adventure Trail and a Disabled access Pirate Ship. Seconded Cllr Barnett, all in favour.

OSC 459 – Allotments

(i)The Committee considered extending Cave Gates, The Moorlands and Market Weighton Tenancy Agreements to five years. Clerk to obtain clarification on the wording and legalities. Cllr L. Turner proposed providing the Parish Council are within their rights to extend agreement lengths, to proceed with a 5 year agreement from October 2018. Seconded Cllr Warren, All in favour.
