A meeting was held for the above committee at the **Town Hall** on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at 8:00p.m.

**TS 370 - To Elect Chair for the year 2018/19**

Cllr Barnett proposed Cllr M. Turner be elected as Chair to the Committee for year 2018/19. Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

**TS 371 – Apologies**

There were no apologies for absence

**TS 372 - Declarations of Interest**

(i) There were no declaration of interests

**TS 373 - Footpaths**

(i) The committee received updates relating to Trodd at A1034. It was noted three businesses had been contacted in relation to the installation. Businesses were provided with information on the proposals and requested confirmation as to their support of the project and the possibility to donate funding to the project. One business had not provided a response, One business was not in favour of the proposed location of the Trodd and had no funding available and one business was in support of the proposals but did not have funding available. The committee concluded the matter be set aside for the time being unless any additional information evolves which could support the project. Proposed Cllr Munby, Seconded Cllr Warren, All in favour.

**TS 374 - Town Hall**

(i) The Committee considered works to Town Hall render. Cllr Munby proposed the Parish Council proceed with Cook Group quotation at a cost of £550.00 +VAT. Seconded Cllr Warren, All in favour  
(ii) The Committee considered the Government voucher scheme Free Lightstream connection at the Town Hall. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the installation of the Lightstream providing the plans are submitted to the Conservation Officer to ensure the fabric of the Listed Building is not compromised. The voucher scheme covered the complete installation of the connection with only the VAT payable to claim back. Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

**TS 375 - Streets/Roads**

(i) The Committee considered the Festive Light infrastructure installation to Church Street, South Cave. It was noted the ERYC did not recommend festive lighting be installed to Church Street, due to the location of the posts and the possibility of obstructing vehicles at Church Street, South Cave. The Committee requested Clerk obtain prices for the installation of infrastructure to install festive lighting to the posts outside the school, past the Castle and to request the ERYC installer be available to switch on the lights on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018. Proposed Cllr L. Turner, Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

(ii) The Committee considered the Festive light switch on arrangements 2018. A sub-committee involving, Cllrs L. Turner, Barnett, Bateman, Edmond and Tudor-Price be arranged to consider

arrangements and provisionally make enquiries as to the possibility of the hiring of the Family Centre at All Saints Church, Proposed Cllr L. Turner, Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour.

**TS 376 - Streets/Roads**

- (i)The Committee noted a update in relation to installation of Road signage to Wadley Plump, South Cave and meeting arranged for Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2018
- (ii)The Committee received update relating to Beverley Road signage
- (iii)The Committee did not receive additional information relating to the hiring of warning signage for vehicles entering the village due to the ERYC not providing the information
- (iv)DUPLICATE ITEM (i) To receive a update relating to road signage at Wadley plump
- (v)DUPLICATE ITEM TS 373 (i) To receive responses relating to installation of Trodd
- (vi)The Committee discussed the Pedestrian Crossing at Market place. It was noted the ERYC were not accepting improvements to the crossing and the committee did not resolve to proceed with the purchase of any modernisation. The Committee requested the matter be placed on hold to be revisited in future once Building Works commence at Market Place, South Cave (Land at The Stray)

**TS 377 - Other Matters**

- (i) The Committee received information relating to social media. Cllr Warren proposed the Parish Council proceed with a trial twitter account for three month limiting ‘Tweets’ to Agendas and Events only. Seconded Cllr Barnett, Vote 4 in favour, 2 abstention, 1 Against
- (ii)The committee received an update and discuss matters arising relating to Grass Cutting services. It was noted the new Contractor has provided an excellent service to date having received a number of positive comments on various locations
- (iii)The Committee considered and discussed matters arising relating to Drainage & ERYC Flood alleviation scheme update. It was noted the ERYC were in the process of approving the flood alleviation scheme and would present to the Parish Council once finalised. Clerk advised no contact had been received in relation to this and would chase the matter accordingly.
