OSC 458 - Apologies

There were no apologies for absence

OSC 459 – Declarations of Interest

(i) There were no declarations of interest

OSC 463 – Cemetery

(i) The committee noted works completed for hard standing at cemetery Tap – agreed in minute reference: OSC463 (iii)

(ii) The committee considered price received for the removal a yew trees in cemetery, Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the works at a cost of £220.00 by Mr I. Donkin.

Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

OSC 464 – Playpark

(i) The Committee noted update relating to trees in playpark, South Cave Sports and Recreation arranging a meeting with the ERYC, updates to be provided when received

(ii) The Committee noted the arrangement of installation of self closing gate hinges & associated costs, parts cost at £12.00 per fitting + Labour. Proposed L. Turner, Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

(iii) The Committee considered repairs to wetpour surface due to damage caused by bonfire including inspection of zip wire seat height. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the repair works at a cost of £250.00 + VAT, Seconded Cllr Edmund, All in favour

(iv) The Committee considered repairs to various areas of wood edging around wetpour, two estimates received one including a full overview of the site, providing a estimate of costs totalling £1020.00. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the second price received at a cost of £185 for the replacement of wood edging where required, due to the Playpark being inspected by ROSPA who provide a professional Health and Safety report annually due September 2018. Any associated works raised within the report to be reviewed by the Parish Council and works completed. Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour.

OSC 465– King Georges Field

(i) The Committee noted the submission of Lottery Grant funding, Clerk to provide update once received

OSC 466 – Allotments

(i) The Committee discussed information received from solicitor in relation to Market Weighton Poor Land registration & received correspondence from Market Weighton United Charities including Freedom of Information request. Clerk advised a meeting had been arranged with the Wilkin Chapman Solicitors to establish the best way forward and consider Freedom of Information request. Matter to be placed on Full Council agenda of the 16th July 2018

OSC 467 – Other Matters

(i)The Committee received information relating to discussions with Risby Homes in relation to s106 agreement and Open Spaces agreements. Matter to be discussed at the next meeting to consider requirements under the lease and handover of land.

(ii)The Committee considered Public Spaces Protection Orders Consultation 2019 – Alcohol consumption, it was noted the current locations within the order include: Playpark, School Carpark/Playpark, Church Street Carpark, Church Hill, Church Yard, Bull Pasture & South Cave Primary School site. The Committee requested the matter be placed on a future agenda as submissions to adjustments in the areas will be reviewed early 2019, it was noted a possible location to include may be the Seating area around Costcutters.

(iii)The Committee noted the position of bin as advised by ERYC at Steep Hill as being re-identified to be installed to the bottom of Steep Hill next to the sign this is due to bin being installed on non ERYC land. Cllr Warren proposed the Parish Council proceed with the installation as identified by the ERYC. Cllr M, Turner proposed a adjustment to the proposal to recommend the ERYC consider two locations, one being the bottom of Steep Hill, the second location to the entrance of footpath number 25 on Beverley Road, the proposal did not receive a Second. Cllr Barnett, Seconded Cllr Warren proposal to proceed with the location identified by ERYC. All in favour.
