OSC 475 - Apologies

There were no apologies for absence

OSC 476 – Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest

OSC 477 – Cemetery

(i) The Committee discussed the number of Burial plot reservations and requested Clerk make enquiries as to similar cemeteries rules relating to reservations. Cllr Barnett proposed the Committee recommend the Parish Council place a temporary restriction on reservations for those wishing to reserve future plots. Seconded Cllr L. Turner, All in favour

(ii)The Committee considered the purchase of small salt bin to be located next to the tap in the cemetery. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Committee recommend the Parish Council proceed with a small plastic bin/box to be placed next to the water tap. Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

OSC 478 – Playpark

(i)The Committee noted and received the completed of ROSPA inspection and considered maintenance works identified as Medium/High Risk items. It was noted no High Risk Items were identified. Clerk provided the Committee with an overview of works for the items detailed as Medium Risk at a total cost of £ 1643. Cllr Barnett proposed the Committee recommend the Parish Council proceed with the works identified, Seconded Cllr Bateman, 4 in favour, 3 abstentions

OSC 478– King Georges Field

(i)The Committee noted the completion of ROSPA inspection

(ii)The Committee received the complaint relating to King George V Playing field hedge cutting, it was noted the hedge had been cut. The Committee requested Clerk make contact with the Management for Wold View to advise the owners of propertied backing onto the field, the hedge should not be cut and no gates with access to the field are permitted.

OSC 473 – Allotments

(i)The Committee received information from Wilkin Chapman LLP relating to Market Weighton Poor Land - Land Registry. The Committee noted funding was in place for further communications/meeting which would be arranged once all information had been received from Land Registry.

OSC 474 – Grass Cutting

(i)The Committee considered pricing received to include within 2019/20 budgets, total fees to be estimated at £6871.50. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Committee recommend the Parish Council proceed with the Contractors – DJ Landscapes for the services for 2019/20. Seconded Cllr M. Turner, all in favour.

OSC 474 – Other Matters

- (i)The Committee received a complaint relating to bin located at Steep Hill, the committee considered and reviewed the location and requested Clerk advise the ERYC the location is unsuitable due to safety reasons and request the bin be reinstalled at a more suitable location.
- (ii)The Committee received information relating to Open Spaces – Risby Homes Development and requested a subcommittee meeting be arranged to discuss the matter further
