## **A63 North Cave to South Cave Safety Barrier Installation**

As Highways England's contractor in Yorkshire and North Lincolnshire, we are writing to advise you of planned roadworks due to commence on the A63 between North Cave and South Cave.

### What's happening and when?

Work is expected to start on 14 January 2019 and until April 2019. It includes installing approximately 4km of new safety barrier in the eastbound and westbound verges and removing and replacing 7 lighting columns. We're also replacing 6 traffic signs and permanently closing the disused VOSA layby in the westbound carriageway.

### Closures, restrictions and diversions

Due to a lack of hard shoulder in the area resulting in a reduction of available working space it is necessary to fully close the eastbound carriageway overnight to do this work. We'll do this between 8pm and 6am Monday to Friday for around 8 weeks. Once complete, work will start on the westbound carriageway overnight until the scheme completes in April 2019. Access for the emergency services will be unaffected and will remain available throughout.

A clearly signed diversion route will be in place and drivers should add an additional 25 minutes to their journey. The main eastbound diversion will require drivers to leave the M62 junction 37 at Howden and follow the diversion via A614, A1079, and A1034, re-joining the A63 at South Cave and vice versa for the westbound closure.

### Additional information and how to contact us

There is also further work on two major projects on the A63 in Hull. Princes Quay bridge, which will link the marina with the southern end of Princes Dock and Roger Millward Way where an extra lane will be added through the middle of the roundabout.

The bridge will improve access for pedestrians, cyclists and disabled users to cross the A63 while major junction improvements at Roger Millward Way will help reduce congestion and smooth the flow of traffic.

We will work with our partners to keep disruption to traffic and residents to a minimum. Please accept our apologies in advance for any disruption you may experience.
