TS 399 – Apologies

TS 400 - Declarations of Interest

TS 401 - Town Hall

- (i)The Committee noted the repairs to Town Hall flood lights had been arranged with the ERYC
- (ii)The Committee requested Clerk obtain prices to fix and relocated the Intercom system
- (iii)The Committee considered Town Hall upstairs office storage, Clerk to arrange for the room to be cleared and the U3A in the process of documenting their archives in order to store at the Town Hall. It was noted the U3A were to provide a cabinet for storage
- (iv)The Committee noted Town Hall back gate replacement works to be completed

TS 402 - Festive Lights

- (i)The Committee discussed festive lighting arrangements 2019/20, it was noted the event had been arranged at Cave Castle for Saturday 30th November 2019, the Parish Council to collect donations on the gate for Yorkshire Air Ambulance & the Committee considered fundraising events, Cllr Edmund volunteered to arrange a quiz night to fundraise for additional lighting to be installed at Church Hill, and the summer fayre at Cave Castle for the Parish Council to collect donations with buckets.
- (ii) The Committee considered the hire of Festive lighting to Streetlights at Church Hill, at a cost of £200 per column to be fixed to five columns providing they are suitable, further information to be provided to Committee and Full Council once received. Proposed Cllr L. Turner, Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour
- (iii)The Committee noted that testing and repairs to existing Parish Council owned Festive lighting would be required prior to the festive period. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council obtain a price for testing of the lights to establish the works required. Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

TS 403 - Streets/Roads

- (i) The Committee noted update relating to Market Place zebra Crossing improvements the ERYC had raised the job and the improvements to be made in the near future. Funding was in placed from Donations and partial funding from the ERYC
- (ii)The Committee village signage, bus stops and warning signage (cleaning and maintenance), Clerk to request Highways clean signage approaching the roundabout to the A1034 at Sewells and arrange for the bus shelters to be cleaned.
