TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC

A1034 Brough Road (part of) and A63 westbound on-slip road.

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along A1034 Brough Road /South Cave roundabout and the A63 westbound on slip road between commencing 5th August 2019 to allow carriageway resurfacing works to take place

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10th August 2019. The works will take place will be between 20:00hrs and 06:00hrs,

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be as follows

Traffic from South Cave wishing to access A63 westbound carriageway:

A63 south east bound carriageway, exit slip road to Elloughton / Brough/Welton, Welton Road, Water Lane merging to A63 westbound carriageway.

Traffic From Hull wishing to exit at South Cave:

Continue on the A63 to the North Cave intersection off Slip, Main Road, Newport Road, A63 Eastbound on Slip to A63 South Cave off slip.

Traffic from Ellerker and Elloughton wishing to access the Westbound carriageway:

Brough Road, Roman Road, Stockbridge Road Roundabout, Stockbridge Road, Welton Low Road, Welton Road, Water Lane merging to A63 westbound carriageway.

Traffic from Brough wishing to access the Westbound carriageway:

Welton Road, Welton Road Roundabout, Water Lane, merging to A63 westbound carriageway.

The road will be closed to all traffic, but access will be maintained at all time for emergency services and pedestrians

TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION TO 30MPH AND 10MPH
BROUGH ROAD SOUTH CAVE (PART OF):

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from exceeding 30mph along Brough Road South Cave extending from the A63 overbridge to approx 150 metres from the A63 roundabout, commencing Monday 5th August 2019 in the interest of highway safety during resurfacing works. A further speed restriction of 10mph will be in operation between the hours of 20:00 and 06:00 during convoy working for each 500metre section of works.

The speed restrictions are necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the restriction will be lifted by 10th August 2019.
