A meeting was held of the Open Space Committee on **Monday 9th September 2019** at the **Town Hall** at 7:00p.m

OSC 490 - Apologies

Cllr L. Turner proposed apologies be accepted from Cllrs Munby & Edmond, Seconded Cllr Bateman

OSC 491 – Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest

OSC 492 – King Georges Field

(1)The Committee noted repairs completed to Pirate Ship

(2)The Committee considered future project for installation of additional equipment at a cost of around £33k, Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council agree to the installation in principle, and to approve final installation with costs being Commuted Sums when available, Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

(3)The Committee to arrange meeting with ERYC relating to commuted sums in relation to the installation of play equipment in King George V Playing field

OSC 494 – Allotments

(1)The Committee received correspondence relating to Market Weighton Allotment Charity and requested matter be placed on a Full Council Agenda for discussion

(2)The Committee noted there were no outstanding allotment rates & considered previous tenant request for refund in rates (handed in notes 1 week after making payment). Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council arrange a refund due to the termination of the agreement of only 1 week. Seconded Cllr M. Turner, All in favour

OSC 487 – Playpark

(1)The Committee received a update relating to trees in playpark, it was noted the trees had been maintained as agreement previously

(2)The Committee considered additional tree works in playpark, Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the works at a cost of £350-£400, Seconded Cllr M. Turner, All in favour

OSC 488 – Cemetery

(1)The Committee requested the arrangement of Cemetery inspection to be arranged at Full Council

OSC 489 – Open Space

(1)The committee discussed the Risby Homes open spaces – Water Lane, South Cave: Lease arrangements and s137 area, It was noted the Lease was being handled by the solicitors, Clerk had requested Risby Homes resubmit their plan to include a fence around the parameter of the Gravel Playspace as this would not be permitted parking. Item to be placed on a future Full Council agenda for discussion

(2)The Committee discussed Rawdale Close maintenance and request for removal of conifers and specific plants. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council make arrangements for the removal, pricing to be submitted to Full Council, Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

(3)The Committee discussed disabled access to Bull Pasture, it was noted the matter had been referred to the ERYC as the gated access was the responsibility of the ERYC

(4)The Committee noted the works to the tree at Bull Pasture matter had been referred to the ERYC and was awaiting a response
