TS 413 – Apologies

Cllr L. Turner proposed apologies be accepted from Cllr Munby & Edmond, Seconded Cllr Bateman

TS 414 - Declarations of Interest

There was no declaration of interests

TS 415 - Town Hall

- (1)The Committee noted the completed installation of shed
- (2) The Committee consider Town Hall maintenance works, it was noted any works to the rear window would require to be approved by the ERYC conservation officer
- (3)The Committee discussed tip/rubbish removal and requested Clerk obtain a price for ERYC to remove items
- (4)The Committee noted the confidential waste removal and approved the costs at £6.50 a bag. Arrangements to be made for this

TS 416 - Festive Lights

- (1)The Committee discussed festive lighting arrangements 2019/20 it was noted Cave Castle were making arrangements with the inclusion of the Parish Council
- (2)The Committee noted update on fundraising event ‘Autumn Sesh’ to be held Friday 18th October 2019 and to make arrangement for informal meeting with volunteers at a suitable informal venue
- (3)The Committee noted the loss/misplacement of Market Stall tops, the Committee requested Clerk establish the location of the Stall Covers and clips

TS 417 - Streets/Roads

- (1) The Committee noted the ERYC had not provided a date for the improvements to Market Place zebra Crossing improvements, the Committee expressed concerns for this as winter was approaching and the works had been paid for. Clerk to request an update and date for works as soon as possible
- (2)The Committee received update relating to Bin sponsorship for Willow Flats Junction. It was noted a local Business had expressed their intentions to sponsor a bin, funding amount not yet known and details to be provided once received.
- (3)The Committee considered Bacchus/Burland Rise Road signage. The Committee requested the ERYC install signage detailing Bacchus Lane leading to Burland Rise signage.
- (4)The Committee received letter from lifestyle challenge group – Pock Up Promise and considered request for litter bin, the matter to forwarded to the ERYC for consideration

TS 418– Footway Sweeper

- (1)The Committee discussed Footway Cleaning with no comments to raise
- (2)The Committee considered repairs to Green Machine/mechanical tools/Snow Plough & Associated costs. It was noted the costs to repair the Machine exceed its value. A offer had been received to

purchase the Machine at a cost of £300. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the sale. Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour
