FGP 184 – Budgets

(1) The Committee received 2020/21 Grass Cutting pricing from GJ Landscapes at a costs of £7188. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the price received to be included within 2020/21 budgets. Seconded Cllr Munby, All in favour

(2) The Committee received 2020/21 Footway Cleaning pricing from Stafforce at a costs of £9004.32. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the price received to be included within 2020/21 budgets. Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

(3)The Committee noted Clerk salary increase had not been received & Pension contributions were to reduce, the draft budget was adjusted accordingly in order to predict a 2% increase
