TS 419 – Apologies

Cllr L. Turner proposed apologies be accepted from Cllr Barnett, Seconded Cllr Tudor Price

TS 420 - Declarations of Interest

There was no declaration of interests

TS 421- Town Hall

(1)The Committee discussed Town Hall roof and repairs, it was noted that during the recent wet weather the Roof had leaked in the same position as previously identified. P & N Design had attended the Town Hall and suggested the area be rubbed down in order to expose the plasterwork to reveal any further Damp. It was noted a scaffold would be required to re assess the works, a report to be provided to full council and the arrangement of a extra-ordinary meeting to approve works.

TS 422 - Festive Lights

(1)The committee discussed festive lighting arrangements 2020/21 & consider fundraising events and agreed to cancel all events for 2020

(2)The Committee considered installation of Christmas tree a Rawdale Close & Costcutters, Clerk to ensure the ERYC would allow the installation at the land at Costcutters roundabout and consider fundraising for the installation of trees at Church Hill, Rawdale Close and Costcutters

(3)The Committee considered fundraising event for Festive Lighting - Autumn Sesh - October 2020 - In the event of no fundraising being arranged. To rearrange budgets in order to allow for the installation of Church Hill Festive lighting – all events cancelled and fundraising to be arranged, item to be placed on Full Council Agenda for any shortfall to be budgeted.

TS 423 - Streets/Roads

(1)The committee discussed the Streetnaming bank suggestions and suggested the Chair and Clerk collect the information provided and submit the names with majority approval

(2)The committee discussed response relating to warning signage at Common Road \Traffic speeding issues, it was noted Broomfleet Parish Council did not support a speed reduction, the Parish Council referred the complainant to the ERYC for further assistance

(3)The Committee received email from resident relating to PROW 13/5 Crabley Creek, it was noted the ERYC were in the process of rectifying the problem, however this was note high priority and may time some time

(4)The Committee considered the support of resident’s idea to install please take your litter home signage on various PROW locations, and suggested Clerk refer the matter to the ERYC PROW team which may be in a position to install relevant signage
