**OSC 516 - Apologies**

Cllr Barnett proposed apologies be accepted from Cllrs M, Turner & Tudor-Price, Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

**OSC 517 – Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest

**OSC 518 – Allotments**

(1)The Committee did not receive update from ERYC relating to Cavegates & the Moorlands, Representative from First Fruits allotments raise an enquiry relating to the Allotment Tenancy Agreement. Cllr L. Turner proposed the committee would approve the alteration to the name on the agreement when required. Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

**OSC 519 - Cemetery**

- (1)The Committee did not receive update on Registration of Land at Burial Ground – Item to be placed on future agenda once information received
- (2)The Committee noted no response received from the Cave Castle regarding the Land Bid at Burial Ground and requested a follow up letter be submitted
- (3)The Committee received update relating to Yew tree removal and groundworks provided – it was noted the Yew trees had been removed and Stumps Away would commence works when the ground was suitable
- (4)The Committee discussed replacement trees and removal of Dead Trees (one overhanging gravestone). The Committee suggested arrangements be made with the Grounds Contractor to discuss the works and obtain price for works
- (5) The Committee discussed missing fencing around the parameter of the site The Committee suggested arrangements be made with the Grounds Contractor to discuss the works and obtain price for works including the planting of a yew hedgerow

**OSC 520 - King George V**

(1)The Committee received update relating to commuted sums – King George V play equipment , it was noted information had been presented to Full Council with no further update at present

**OSC 521 - Other Matters**

- (1)There was not update to present to committee relating to Westcote Farm s106 agreement (open space)
- (2)The Committee considered the project for installation of tree planters at Market Place and discuss offer of Tree donation for the village, it was noted Clerk had secured funding for planters and was awaiting confirmation from the Tree Donator and ERYC as to the approval of locations
- (3)The Committee discussed village Tree applications and quality of application information submitted by ERYC and discussed TPO Database. The Committee requested a informal meeting be held with the ERYC to discuss and raise Parish Council concerns relating to the loss of trees within the village including trees holding a TPO, the monitoring of the replanting of trees and the information the ERYC provide from applicants supporting applications
- (4)The Committee discussed parked vehicles at Beverley Clump, South Cave – it was noted the PSCO had advised there was not legislation to stop or limit visitors driving and walking in the area during the Pandmic
- (5)The Committee discussed the PROW 12 (Golf Course) redirection, it was suggested the ERYC install additional waymarkers to assist walkers.
