(1)The Parish Council noted there was no further update - s106 agreement and Lease/Licences area at Westcote Farm, clerk to chase the Solicitors for further action

(2)The Parish Council received update relating to identified locations for local business - Tree Planting Scheme and consider purchase options, it was noted difficulties in identifying suitable planters for the area, Clerk to make contact with the HMPS and Bishop Burton as they may be able to fabricate a design

(3)The Parish Council did not update relating to Land Bid with Cave Castle, clerk to request further updated from the landowner

(4)The Parish Council noted the report for Playpark trees to be completed 28th June 2021

(5)The Parish Council received a price for Playpark Fence repairs and requested comparison estimate be obtained

(6)The Parish Council considered the Fence request at allotment number 24, Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council approve the request, Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

(7)The Parish Council considered the request for installation of memorial plaque in South Cave Cemetery – Seat located adjacent to Plot Y1. The Parish Council did not resolve to authorise the installation of brass plate on the seat as requested but did suggest a tree could be planed within the cemetery to a location chosen by the Parish Council.

(8)The Parish Council considered the request for Memorial Seat Maintenance at Little Wold Lane, South Cave. The Parish Council requested the request be forwarded to the ERYC for maintenance

Other Matters

(1)The Parish Council noted and received the Letter of thank you from resident relating to Sliproad and pedestrian improvement works

(2)The Parish Council noted the arrangements for 2021 South Cave 10K run

(3) The Parish Council did not receive a response received re: Gas Pipes at Church Street due to no contact being made from the ERYC or Northern Gas

(4)The Parish Council received update relating to request for informal meeting relating to Planning applications - Trees and TPO and received Data information, the Parish Council requested a informal meeting to be arrangement to discuss the information in order to proceed further

(5) The Parish Council received information relating to the Bin at West End and request from West End Cafe to remove Bin located. The Parish Council noted the ERYC had not identified a more suitable position for the bin (on the verge to the junction of Appleton Gardens) and it was noted the only suitable location would be to move no more than two metres to the right next to the adjacent Grass Verge, remaining on the Tarmac within the same vicinity of the existing bin, therefore the Parish Council did not resolve to move, replace or relocate the bin

(6)The Parish Council noted the ERYC consultation - Proposed Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order at Drewton Estate, South Cave, HU15 2AG and Rowley Footpath No. 16, Brick Dike Lane, HU20 3UP

(7)The Parish Council received residents request for Parish Council request a Speed Survey at Beverley Road, South Cave, it was noted that recently the Safer Roads Humber had been frequently visiting which should deter speeding vehicles

(8)The Parish Council considered maintenance of seat located at Market Place, South Cave and requested details be forwarded to the ERYC for consideration on the maintenance plan

(9)The Parish Council considered arrangements for the Marking of the Queens Platinum Jubilee – 4 day bank Holiday 2-5 June 2022. The Parish Council to arrange an informal meeting to discuss arrangements

(10)The Parish Council resolved to purchase additional 30 Lamppost Poppies as replacement for damaged items and additional installations at a cost of £3.00 per poppy

(11)The Parish Council noted the A63 Highways England Maintenance works

(12)The Parish Council received email request from resident relating to Parking Permits and did not resolve to support parking permits within the area
