OSC 525- Apologies

There were no apologies for absence

OSC 526 – Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest

OSC 527 – Playpark

- (1)The Parish Councillors received report for Playpark trees, it was noted that minor maintenance had been completed and regular inspections would be arranged in accordance with the report
- (2)The Parish Councillors received information relating to Playpark repair works to the Rounabout. The Parish Councillors requested alternative options be obtained
- (3)The Parish Councillors considered the price received for Playpark seat/Bench maintenance, and proposed the works be completed at a cost of £215.00

OSC 528 - Cemetery

- (1)The Parish Councillors noted the semi-retirement of Grave Digger – 48 years service and thanked him for his professional services throughout the period, it was noted he would carry on duties within the Garden of Remembrance and a new Gravedigger was in place
- (2)The Parish Councillors noted the completion of Cemetery Inspection and notified plot owners of breach in rules.

OSC 524 - King George V Playing Field

- (1)The Parish Councillors received Commuted Sums Grant offer and formally considered acceptance to be signed at Full Council 20th September 2021

OSC 525 - Open Space

- (1)The Parish Councillors received update - s106 agreement, any further information to be provided when received
- (2)The Parish Councillors received information from the ERYC response relating to Seat Maintenance around the village and requested prices be obtained for the maintenance of the Memorial seats at Little Wold land and Market Place
- (3)The Parish Councillors received Amendment Request Form relating to the 2022 review of Public Spaces Protection Orders, item to be discussed once the Land at Westcote Farm has been signed over

OSC 526 - Allotments

(1)The Parish Councillors noted the completion of Allotment Inspection, all allotments which were in need of attention have been contacted, two of which have been re-allocated to new tenants. Parish Councillors considered the price received for the installation of new Plot Markers and new Noticeboard and proposed the Parish Council accept the price received totalling £220.00

(2)The Parish Councillors discussed Allotment Land agreements, and requested All allotments (excluding Garden Allotments) be placed on Three year tenancy agreements

(3)The Parish Councillors discussed the suspected Allotment produce thefts and requested further information be obtained relating to Police signage at the site
