ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
Church Street and Church Hill, South Cave

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Church Street and Church Hill, South Cave between the junction with West End and the junction with Market Place commencing 18th October 2021 to allow works for carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works to be carried out in safety.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 5 days.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Market Place, Brough Road, Willow Flats, Ellerker Lane, Water Lane, West End and vice versa.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure.

The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for emergency vehicle, residents and pedestrians.
