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Police

(1)Introductions were made by Chief Inspector and PSCO's, it was noted the area was not subject to any increase in crime, the play area had been included within the Police Tasking App, ensuring regular visits to the site. It was noted the Police.com website had not updated the crime figures since May 2022, Chief Inspector was to look into this problem. Regular advice for residents to be advertised reminding residents of the 101 non emergency number.

Concerns were raised with police regarding the speeding traffic within the area and suggested the residents consider involvement with speedwatch. Incidents had been reported at The Bear Inn – the police were confident the area would be visited promptly following an incident being logged

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Other Matters

(1)The Parish Council received update from ERYC relating to the turning outside Boots from Church Street onto Market Place – ERYC had confirmed a bollard was to be installed at the junction outside the Boots Chemist, this would deter the mounting of the kerb for left hand

(2)The Parish Council noted the submission for The Bear Inn – listing for Asset of Community Value

(3)The Parish Council discussed Ellerker Lane parking problems, and requested the ERYC review the Design for turning heavy goods vehicles at Ellerker Lane

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Festive Event

(1)The Parish Council considered donation for Festive Event, Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council donate funding totalling £250.00 for the festive event. Seconded Cllr Barnett, vote 8 in favour, 1 against, 1 abstention

(2)The Parish Council considered attendance to South Cave Sports Centre – Festive Market to be held Sunday 20th November 2022, there was no decision to officially attend the event but representatives may be present
