OSC 566 – Apologies for Absence

There were no apologies for absence

OSC 567 – Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest

OSC 568 – Allotments

(1)The Committee noted meeting arranged with ERYC to discuss drainage issues and locations at Cave Gates & The Moorlands arranged for 14th December 2022

(2)The Committee discussed the Garden Allotment Agreement and considered the inclusion of items: Tree Planting & removal of fruit trees on termination of agreement – Cllr Edmond proposed the items be included with the Allotment Agreements commencing May 2023, Seconded Cllr Munby, All in favour **There should be no planting of any species of trees including fruit trees within the allotment garden without prior permission from the Parish Council. Allotment holders must remove any trees/shrubs planted within the plot on termination of the agreement**

(3)The committee noted the price for the supply of Hardcore for Access track was not yet received

OSC 569 – Cemetery

(1)The Committee considered additional Memorial Seat, price and location and requested a meeting to be arranged to identify location

OSC 570 – Westcote Farm/Open Space

(1)The Committee discussed in brief the rules of site and considered price for the installation of Notice Board. Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council proceed with the purchase and installation, seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

(2)The Committee received update relating to PSPO, ERYC were considering the application

(3)The Committee considered the official renaming of site by Full Council resolution following advice from Solicitors, Cllr L. Turner proposed the Parish Council resolve to rename the site Queen Elizabeth II, Seconded Cllr Edmond, All in favour

OSC 571 – Trees/Hedges

(1)The Committee received update relation to donation of tree for Westcote Farm, it was noted GJ Landscapes would install the tree once arrangements had been made

(2)The Committee discussed additional donation of trees for Bull Pasture, Cllrs to visit site to establish numbers of trees required

(3)The Committee received update relating to Tree Planting scheme 2022

(4)The Committee discussed advertisement for local volunteers for the upkeep of Flowers beds at Castle Drive entrance for Parish Newsletter, it was noted two volunteers had showed interest in maintenance of the site

OSC 572 – King George V / Playparks / Open Space

(1)The Committee discussed issues relating to anti social behaviour, Cllr Munby proposed the inside of the Lighthouse Tower be painted black in a attempt to cover the graffiti and prevent further graffiti to the equipment, Seconded Cllr Edmond, All in favour
