(1)The Parish Council noted Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding across the Level Crossing on Crabley Lane, South Cave (The road will be closed 20 meters either side of the Level Crossing). The closure is to commence on the 8th January 2023 to allow for railway inspection works to be carried out in safety. There is no diversion in place for vehicles affected by the road closure.
