The Parish Council noted 23/00110/TCA: Proposal: SOUTH CAVE E CONSERVATION AREA - Crown lift 1 no. Sycamore tree (1) to 5 meters to clear BT cables; Crown lift 2 no. Oak trees (2) to 2 meters to remove vandalised limbs; Crown lift 1 no. Sycamore tree (3) and 1 no. Oak tree (4) to 2 meters to improve pedestrian headroom Location: King George V Playing Field Bacchus Lane South Cave East Riding Of Yorkshire Applicant: South Cave Parish Council Application Type: Tree Works in Conservation Areas ** this application is the Parish Councils submission for essential Tree works to be completed with a expiry of 31st January 2023

The Tap in the cemetery had been replaced due to a burst pipe, it was apparent the pipe connecting to the main Yorkshire Water Pipe was also damage. Currently the water was disconnection pending repairs

A discussion was held with the breach of Tenancy Agreement at The Moorlands and Cave Gates allotments, Sheet had been placed for grazing at Cave Gates and The Moorlands was being prepared for grazing also, the Parish Council requested the immediate removal of the sheep from the land, due to a breach in agreements with immediate effect. The ERYC would be inspecting The Moorlands Electric fencing to ensure this is suitable for its location next to a PROW. All in favour.

Three streetlights were reported as being faulty/out

The entrance sign to the village at Station Road was in need of a clean – Cllr Thornham offered assistance with this.
