**Emergency Temporary closure of Public Footpath No.10 in the Parish of South Cave**  
**and part of Public Footpath No.02 in the Parish of Ellerker**

The East Riding of Yorkshire Council hereby gives notice that no person shall use South Cave Public Footpath No.10 and part of Ellerker Public Footpath No.02, between Woodale House and Mount Airy Farm, approximately 700metres to the northwest.

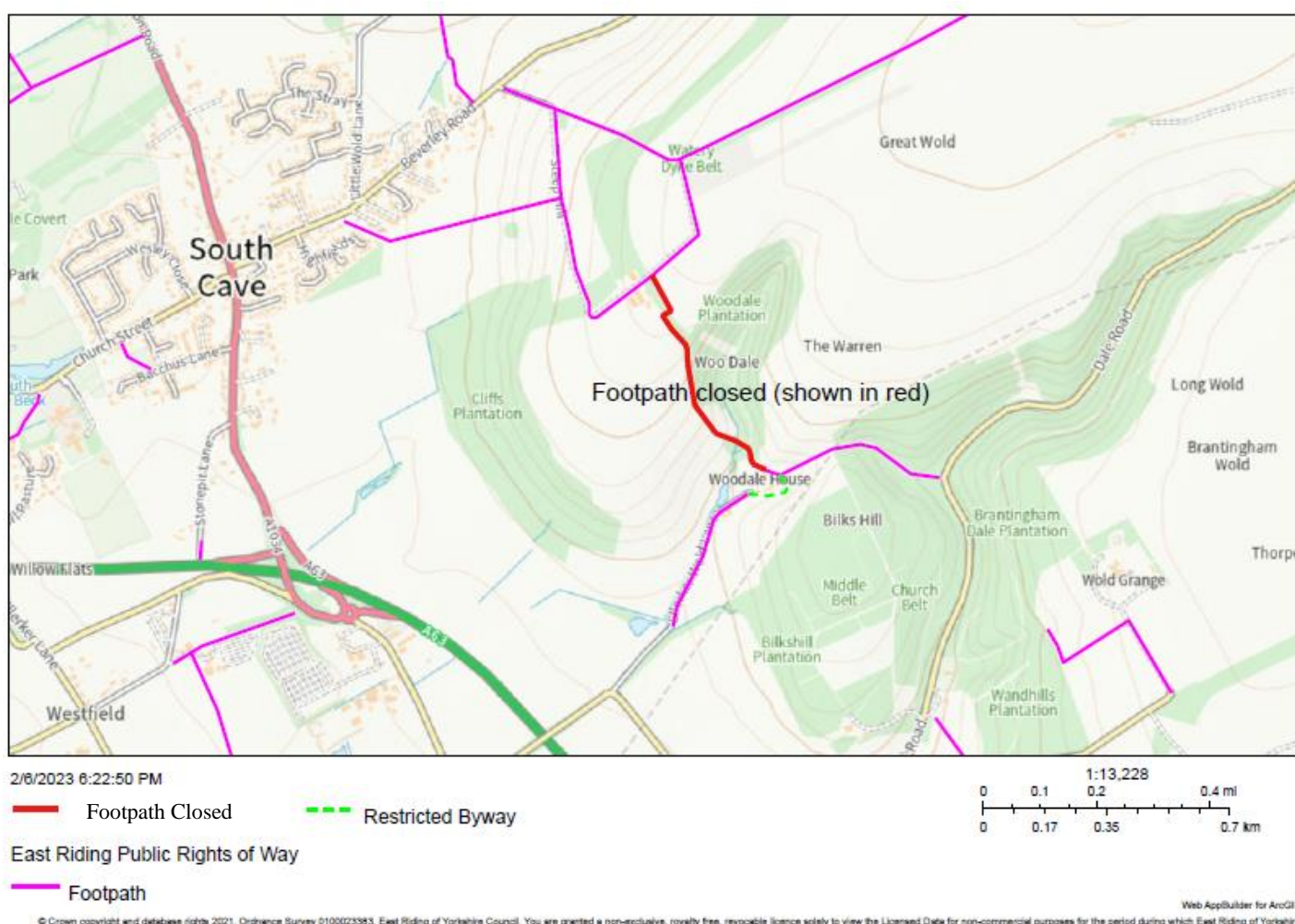
The closure is required to ensure public safety while tree safety works are carried out immediately adjacent to the public footpath.

This Emergency Closure Order commences on the 7<sup>th</sup> February 2023 and will last for a period of 21 days or until the emergency works are completed.
