**OSC 578 – Election of Committee Chairman for 2023/24**

Cllr Barnett proposed Cllr Edmond as Chair for 2023/24, Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

**OSC 579 – Apologies for Absence**

Cllr Barnet proposed that apologies be accepted from Cllrs Long & Turner, Seconded Cllr Tudor-Price, All in favour

**OSC 580 – Declarations of Interest**

Cllr Tudor-Price declared a non pecuniary interest in minute reference: OSC 583 (2)

**OSC 581 – Allotments**

(1)The Committee update regards supply of Hardcore for Access track and requested prices be obtained for the purchase of Hardcore for the infilling of the access track.

**OSC 582 – Cemetery**

(1)The Committee discussed Chaffer Bug Damage to Cemetery grass and the repair works already successfully completed. The area to be treated by GJ Landscapes in due course.

(2)The Committee discussed future Cemetery Tree works and requested AB Forestry visit the location to provide an overview/pricing for Tree works 2024/25. Works had already been completed to trees on the parameter of the Grounds for 2023/24.

(3)The Committee considered future maintenance projects to Boundary Wall, Lynch Gate & Chapel, the Committee requested prices be obtained for the following projects with a view to build budgets in order to proceed with planned works over a period of time:

Cemetery Wall to entrance of Carpark – Cracked wall needs repairs

Lynch Gate – Tiles to roof, rewaxing & replacing ironworks

Seat area to Entrance to Lynch Gate – Garden Area clearing and graveling for easy maintenance

Chapel – for Full Council to discuss the Chapel, Clerk to requested a price for Structural Survey to be completed

**OSC 583 – King George V / Playparks /Open Space**

(1)The Committee Considered Fencing repair works. Cllr Bateman proposed the Parish Council proceed with the price received from Ian Donkin, Seconded Cllr Tudor-Price, All in favour

(2)The Committee discussed the open space at Costcutters, the consideration for local businesses to sponser the area by way of planting and maintaining raised beds had been submitted to the ERYC and awaiting a response

(3)The committee discussed Rawdale Close maintenance. A price to be obtained for the removal of the ornate logs located on the site and the removal of a tree root damaging the footpath to the scout hut
