Grit Bins are located around the village for the use of gritting the roads/paths in the immediate vicinity. Salt from salt bins is only for use on the public highway, not on private property.

It is an offence to prune, fell or damage a tree in a conservation area without giving notice. In recognition of the special contribution of trees, conservation area legislation introduced in 1967 includes the blanket protection of all trees in a conservation area which have a stem diameter greater than 75mm (3 inches) when measured at 1.5 metres (5 feet) above ground level. For consent to carry out work to trees within a conservation area, you should apply online or download an application form from the ERYC website at www.eastriding.gov.uk

SOUTH CAVE SHOW

This village show is held on August Bank Holiday Monday each year. There are classes to enter for flowers, vegetables, produce (preserves and baking), photography, handicrafts and children's classes. Most of the committee retired after 15 years of putting on the show. We held a meeting and new people agreed to join the committee. South Cave Community Speed Watch

Community Speed Watch is a scheme to allow trained volunteers to address traffic speeding concerns, in order to improve the road safety in their communities.

This is achieved by:

- 1 Undertaking high-visibility roadside monitoring of vehicle speed.
- 2 Report the results of the observation sessions to the police, who in turn will
 - a Send advisory letters to the registered keepers of vehicles reported over the threshold limit.
 - b Use the data gathered to help the Police and others allocate resources and highlight general road safety issues.
- 3 Raising awareness of speeding within communities, the affects it has on people's lives, by educating drivers.

The monitoring locations have been approved and risk assessed by the Police. It is only these locations where the speed watch observations can take place.

Temporary road signs will be deployed.

The speed watch team will be wearing Community Speed Watch high-visibility jackets.

Observations will only take place during daylight hours.

The Household Support Fund aims to help vulnerable households in the East Riding with the rising cost of heating oil. Grants will be awarded to eligible residents and is aimed at low income households.

On application if eligible, households will receive an oil delivery or the LPG alternative and free membership to the YORSwitch Bulk Oil Buying Scheme for the first year (normally £20 per year).

TACKLING ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR IN OUR COMMUNITY

Please find attached issue 29 of our six-monthly updates.

The update informs you of the interventions used in your area and this one sets out those between 1 April and 30 September 2023. I also attach details of the number of calls received by your Anti-Social Behaviour team during this period, the number of neighbourhood watch groups and the number of requests received for community projects.

As we approach Christmas, I would like to pass on a few tips on staying safe and reducing the risk of burglaries in your area. Please pass this on to local residents.

HOME

- Don't leave presents under your Christmas tree if they are visible from windows or doors.
- Never keep large amounts of cash at home.
- Make sure you keep your doors and windows locked at all times.
- Keys should always be kept out of sight and not left in doors or in view of windows.
- Make your house look occupied, use a timer switch to operate lamps as it starts to get dark, leave a radio on.
- Don't open the door to anybody you don't recognise. Not sure? Don't open the door!
