Public Forum

Communication was circulated from correspondence noted from Social Media: David Davis MP on 12 December. I am writing to provide an update on the unacceptable proliferation of telegraph poles in our area. Following receipt of letters from the Chief Executives of MS3 and Connexin, I wrote to the Chief Executive of KCOM. In their letters, both MS3 and Connexin highlighted what they argued to be KCOM abusing their position to put in place barriers to sharing infrastructure. Effectively, they said they had no option but to put up their own telegraph poles. I put those accusations directly to the Chief Executive of KCOM. In response, KCOM's Chief Executive has provided a reply which argues his company is not putting any barriers in place, has "complied with both the letter and spirit" of the regulations, and that the company wishes "to play an active and constructive role in finding a sensible way forward." Given the contradictory statements put forward by the three companies involved, I have organised a meeting between the respective Chief Executives of all three companies and the Members of Parliament for the affected areas. The aim of the meeting, which will take place early in the New Year, is to get to the bottom of the issues that are causing these wholly unacceptable problems for my constituents, and to try to find a solution. I will keep you updated following the meeting.

It was noted roadside debris from vehicle collision should be removed by the vehicle owner or insurers, failure to do so the ERYC make arrangements for removal.
