DITCHES AND WATERCOURSES ARE IMPORTANT

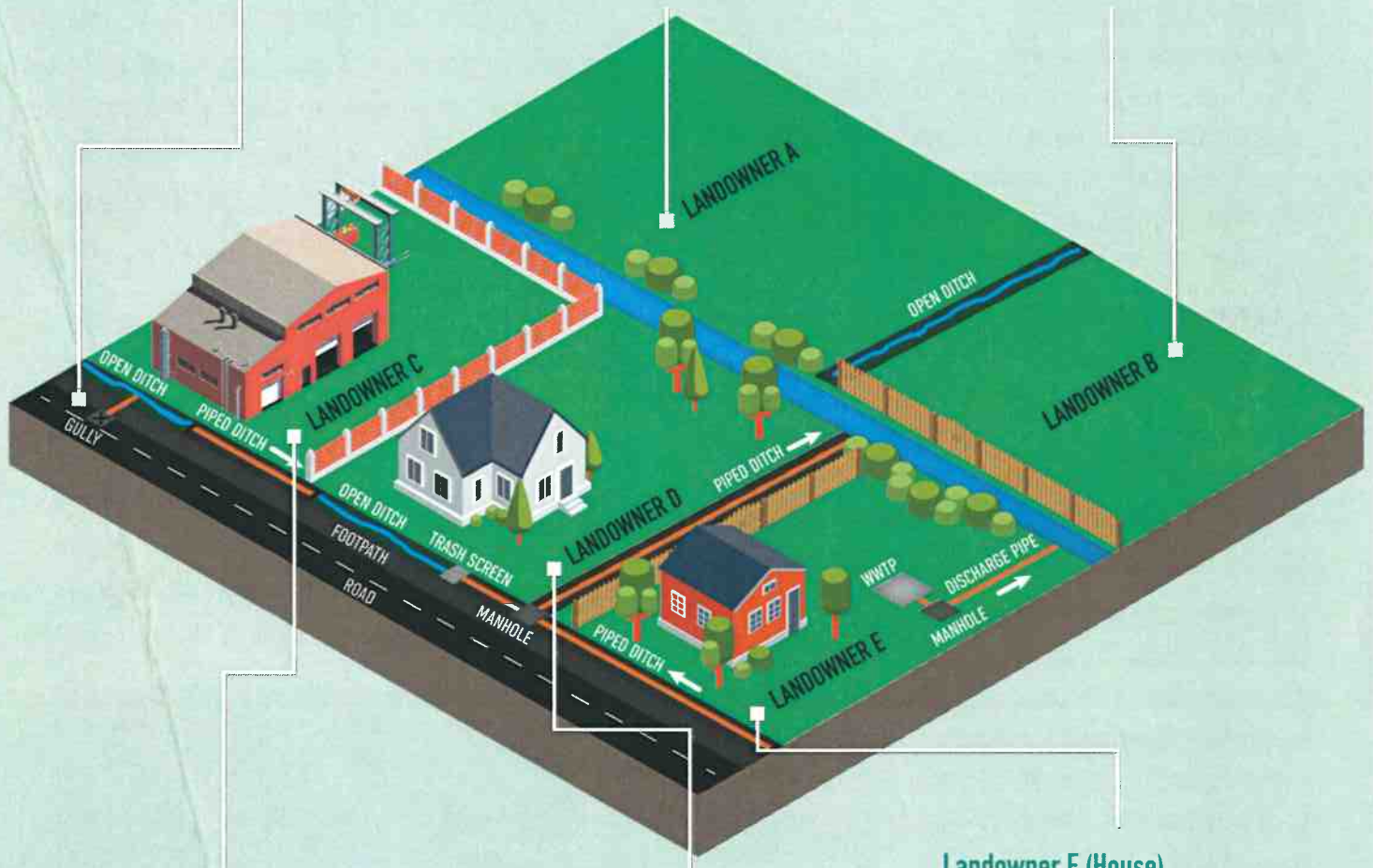
Responsible for the maintenance of the gully and discharge pipe into the open ditch.

Landowner A

Responsible for the maintenance up to the middle point of both the field boundary ditch and the watercourse behind the hedge that borders their land.

Landowner B

Responsible for the maintenance up to the middle point of both the field boundary ditch and the watercourse behind the fence that borders their land.



Landowner C (Business)

Responsible for the maintenance up to the middle point of the watercourse behind the wall that borders their land. They are solely responsible for the pipe running under their access drive and the adjacent open ditch.

Landowner D (House)

Responsible for the maintenance up to the middle point of the watercourse behind the treeline that borders their land. They are solely responsible for the pipe running under their access drive, the adjacent open ditch, the manhole and the trash screen at the front of their land. They are also responsible for the maintenance of the piped ditch that runs under their land to the watercourse.

Landowner E (House)

Responsible for the maintenance up to the middle point of the watercourse behind the hedge line that borders their land. They are solely responsible for the piped ditch running under the front of their land. They are also responsible for the maintenance of the discharge pipe, manhole and connected private wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) that runs under their land to the watercourse.
