




## How to report flooding or an issue involving flooding

Please follow the step-by-step instruction below and the illustrated flowchart on the right.

- Starting on the home screen of the East Riding of Yorkshire Councils website.
  (https://www.eastriding.gov.uk/)
- Using the menu on the left-hand side, select 'Environment'
- Next, select 'Roads, streets, traffic and parking'
- Select 'Roads, Pavements and traffic'
- Then, select 'Flooding and Drainage'. This will take you to the flooding and drainage screen.
- Scroll down to the section titled 'Can I report and issue with a gully, drain, manhole or flooding on the highway'
- Answer the questions in the short questionnaire and then it'll redirect to the enquiry screen where details on the location and the exact issue can be inputted.
