July will see the fourth running of the South Cave 10K

Kingston Upon Hull Athletic Club (KUHAC) have again been given permission by the police and East Riding council to organise the South Cave 10K which will this year be held on Sunday 28 July. It will follow the same course, beginning in the grounds of Cave Castle at 9.00am and running up to Pinfold then round to Water Lane before heading for Ellerker via Common Road. The lead runners will be returning via Water Lane about 30 minutes later before turning into Church Street to run up Wadley Plump and finish next to the Pavilion on the Bull Field. As in previous years, Pat Reay will be invited to present the winner with the Bob Reay Shield in memory of a well-known local runner.

We are expecting about 800 runners this year so there will be some road closures on safety grounds, but we will keep the length of these to a minimum and all corners will be marshalled to ensure that access can be maintained in the event of an emergency. Runners wrote to us after last year's event to comment on the wonderful encouragement they received along the way and how good it was to be applauded and cheered by people as they ran through the village. KUHAC members who acted as marshals also mentioned the friendly reception they received.

We will again be leafletting all the houses and businesses on the route well in advance to give full details of timings and road closures with warning notices put up by the side of roads a couple of weeks before the big day. All the marshals will be briefed to ensure that they collect any rubbish before leaving so we hope that everything will go smoothly and that we will cause the least problems possible.

And if you could pop out to cheer the runners, you might even spot someone you know. As well as runners from across the East Riding, we again expect a good turnout of locals. A

detailed map of the course and of the planned road closures will be available at <https://www.southcave10k.co.uk> as soon as the site opens for entries. Anyone who took part last year will be emailed in advance to give them the first chance to sign up again.

Our chosen charity for 2023 was the Hull Animal Welfare Trust on Pinfold and our race director, David Rivers, was delighted to present them with a cheque for just over £1000. This year's charity will be the Daisy Appeal, supporting their work at Castle Hill hospital fighting cancer.

One change from previous years will be the addition of the Matt Simpson cup to be presented to the first local (HU15) runner to finish. This has kindly been provided by South Hunsley school to mark the loss last year of this much-loved teacher.
