TS 505 - Apologies

Cllr Barnett proposed that apologies be accepted from Cllrs Batemen & Turner, Seconded Cllr Edmond, All in favour

TS 506 - Declaration of Interests

(1) There were no declarations of interest

TS 507 – Traffic, roads and footpaths

(1) The Committee considered the existing Street Name Bank with no additions or adjustments to make

(2) The Committee noted THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2024

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Due to a high amount recorded personal injury collisions and a cluster of collisions at the junction on the B1230 West Hill, South Cave with the A1034, it has been identified by the Road Safety Engineering team as a site to consider further road safety measures to improve road safety. Cllr Edmond proposed the following items be suggested

- 1) Extend the 50mph all the way from the A1034 up the B1230 to the brow of the hill to where the croft of trees are.

- 2) Extend the double white lines all the way from the A1034 up/down the B1230 to the brow of the hill where the croft of trees are.

- 3) Enforce the STOP at the junction joining the A1034 from the B1230 with some form of traffic calming measure.

Vehicles turning onto the B1230 towards Beverley try and race past others up the hill, similarly overtake coming down the hill towards the A1034. If they get it wrong coming down the hill there isn't a runoff lane. Seconded Cllr Foley, All in favour

TS 508 – Festive Lights

(1) The Committee noted replacement Festive lights – Market Place, South Cave & discussed the potential additional locations for Festive lighting

(2) The Committee received update relating to fundraising event for Festive lighting improvements to be held Saturday 13th April 2024 at Little Wold Vineyard

(3) The Committee considered Autumn Sesh fundraising event. Cllr Edmond proposed the Parish Council proceed with the event to be held at Cave Castle Hotel, Friday 18th October 2024, with no costs for the room hire. Entertainment provided by 1034. Ticket price to include Bacon/Sausage bap, profits from ticket sales to be towards the Festive Light improvement fund. Seconded Cllr Tudor-Price, all in favour

(1) The Committee discussed the spring/summer planting within the Planters, with pricing to be obtained for annual maintenance
