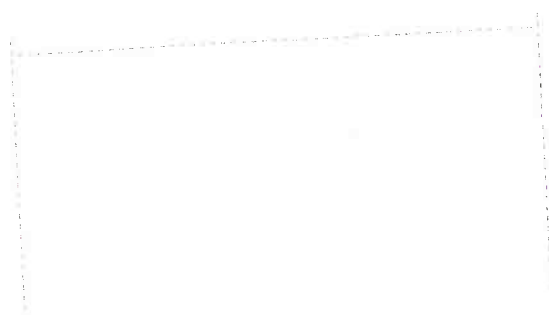

THE SOPHIE AND ELIZABETH BARNARD TRUST

This trust is one of the unique and ancient traditions of South Cave. We are endeavouring to keep it "alive" despite compulsory £60.00 bank charges.

The trust was set up after the will of Elizabeth Barnard, which was written in 1871, to honour her husbands' anniversary. Mrs Barnard left £1000, less taxes, to be distributed amongst the widows, or poor of the parish annually. Obviously this money has dwindled considerably over the years. The trustees meet annually and distribute accordingly. The amount, by today's standards is considerably smaller but so far we have managed to keep this tradition alive, and we are endeavouring to continue this village tradition. "Happy to chat Bench"

The SCPC have nominated a bench near to the library to be our first "Happy to chat Bench" where the sign says, sit here if you don't mind someone stopping to say "Hello".

The idea originally came from our clerk who had read about the concept, which when explained, makes you realise that you may know people that have hidden disabilities. My Granddaughter once said to me: Pops, not all disabilities are visible! This suddenly makes you realise that there are physically fit people but with a hidden illness which could be a mental disorder, loneliness, or have lost a loved one for instance. So, the parish council chose this bench because it is visible, in a relaxing location with views of the castle, and the babbling sounds of the beck immediately behind it. The location is an area in the village where there is lots of footfall, so we encourage you, if you need to chat to go sit at the bench, and to ask the passers-by to think and ask if you need to chat, to Hello!

Remembrance in 2024

This year marks the 80th anniversaries of momentous battles and turning points of the Second World War.

The D-Day landings on June 6, the largest seaborne invasion in history, marked the start of the liberation of western Europe. Other crucial battles, such as the Battle of Monte Cassino in Italy and the Battles of Kohima and Imphal in India, played vital roles in turning the tide of the war.

The 80th Anniversary Celebrations to commemorate D Day on 6th June 2024 will commence at 8:00a.m at the Cenotaph (Church Hill) with the official reading of the Proclamation. All Saints Church and School are hoping to make arrangements for their own activities including the Ringing of the Church Bells for peace at 6:30p.m.

The day will end with the lighting of the Beacon, to be located at the Cenotaph followed by the reading of the international tribute.

The Parish Council will be installing a Single Bespoke design seat at the Cenotaph in due course
