**Public Forum**

The Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee oak tree located on Bull Pasture had not survived it was noted the Clerk had arranged a replacement

It was noted Planning Enforcement were investigating concerns raised with the access to planning application 22/00066/PLF

One tree had suffered damaged at Castle Rise resulting in it falling – ERYC had been informed A request for ERYC to advise where Commuted sums had been allocated – Item placed on future agenda

Sewage Treatment works were causing concerns for residents – It was noted large amounts of tankers were visiting the site 24/7 to disperse sewage to various other sites – Further information required matter to be placed on future agenda.

Cllr Edmond proposed the Parish Council recommend refusal of the application due to the belief that this is in breach of the requirement of general binding regulations and as a result the Parish Council request Planning Officers work with the applicant with a view to finding a way to seeing all surface an foul waste removed from the site by tanker. Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

- (1)The Parish Council noted update: D Day 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration ‘The 80th Anniversary Celebrations to commemorate D Day on 6th June 2024 will commence at 8:00a.m at the Cenotaph (Church Hill) with the official reading of the Proclamation. All Saints Church and School are hoping to make arrangements for their own activities including the Ringing of the Church Bells for peace at 6:30p.m. The day will end with the lighting of the Beacon, to be located at the Cenotaph followed by the reading of the international tribute.’ The Parish Council noted the seat had been ordered to be installed and located at the Cenotaph. It was noted a grant fund had been launched (see Ward Cllrs Report)



3 **Play park Trees**  
(1) The Parish Council received an update regarding Tree (T4) In the Play Park and considered removal costs. Three prices were received for the felling. It was noted due to the Lease being inconclusive with regards to the responsibility of maintenance of the trees within the playpark, Sports and Recreation committee named the Landlord, would agree 50% liability of costs incurred. The Parish Council agreed the preferred contractor for works would be Tree Engineers at a cost of £ 4730. 50% of these costs would be paid through the Grant 137 procedure once the works had been completed and invoice received.
