1 Apologies for absence

2 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest

3 The Paish Council received briefing relating to COLAS AND NATIONAL HIGHWAYS SOCIAL VALUE PROJECTS IN SOUTH CAVE

We received communications from Colas (who are carrying out the A63 works on behalf of National Highways). Colas are working on the A63 improvements along with several other companies, Colas have a variety of social value opportunities which coincide with their current contract and are looking at activities that will have a positive impact on residents potentially affected by the work.

There are a few areas they are looking at such as Careers talks and Road Safety talks with local schools.

Colas Ltd have approached the Parish Council to establish any ongoing projects which may be eligible for funding and or support; I have advised them of the following:

1. South Cave Playpark – replacement footpath
2. Cemetery – Lych Gate Repairs
3. Queen Elizabeth II field – Learning/Reading
4. Allotment Fencing works
5. King George V Playing field – Sensory play, disabled swing and infant swings
6. Road to York has traffic issues - residents group to look at things like installing posts with “ reduce speed limit” signs - this project is being discussed directly with the sub-committee of residents
7. All Saints Church Grade I listed building that needs a lot of work on the church tower. National Highways have a pot of funding for community projects – Contact will be made directly with All Saints Church regarding this matter

The following three projects were favoured to be eligible for Funding under the scheme in the following order of likelihood of approval

1. King George V Playing Field
2. Playpark Footpath
3. Allotment Fencing Works

It was noted Colas may be able to assist with Queen Elizabeth II project, further discussions to be made regarding this.

Cllr Edmond proposed the Parish Council proceed with King George V Playing field grant application for the installation of two cradle swings, one bucket disabled swing & two sensory items. Seconded Cllr Turner, all in favour
