(1)The Parish Council received presentation from three residents wishing to raise awareness of dangerous driving and traffic related hazards to pedestrians around the village. The meeting was closed at 7:15pm for residents to express their concerns **attachment

The Parish Council discussed the action which could be taken to assist with a safety scheme which would benefit the residents of south cave:

To form a sub- committee to bring together the school, ERYC, Residents, Parish Council, Ward Cllr Meredith and Police

The Committee to investigate behaviours and ideas on how to change attitudes on the safety of pedestrians, to empower and influence drivers

To encourage residents to join the Community Speedwatch group

Identify Grant funding which may be available for low level signage on grass verges and lampposts
Publish within the Parish Newsletter

Police

(1)PSCO Danby & Colleague were present at the meeting, they did not have anything of any concern to report with no trend to make residents aware of. They now hold access to a speed laser camera which can be identified to be used, in areas of particular concern, Ferry Road, Church Hill, Water Lane, Ferry Road, Beverley Road & Marke Place South Cave
PSCO Danby advised herself and PSCO Lynch make contact with South Cave CE school to Involve the school with speed awareness around the village.

Other Matters

Item (1) as noted in minute reference: 615820724

(2)The Parish Council discussed response from ERYC regarding traffic speeds, it was noted the ERYC had been made aware of the traffic related speed problems at Water Lane, and the PSCO present noted the location to be attended. The Community speedwatch group had attending Water Lane and had identified a decrease in speeding vehicles on this occasion. It was suggested the complainant be invited to join to sub-committee – safety scheme, which would include raising awareness regarding speeding for the whole village

The expression of interest – 20mph speed limit trial was discussed, Cllr Turner proposed the Parish Council forward the following locations for consideration to the scheme: Church Street, Water Lane, Ferry Road & Beverley Road, Seconded Cllr Edmond, All in favour

(3)The Parish Council noted the repairs to Roll of Honour – to be completed

(4)The Parish Council noted the Date stone in need of restoration. It was noted the conservation officer had visited the site and advise the date stone could be replicated within a new Blue cast iron plaque to be placed within the Window Arches to the Town Hall. Artwork and prices to be obtained.

(5)The Parish Council noted THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC Beverley Road, South Cave Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Beverley Road, South Cave between no.72 to the side of No.1 The Lea commencing 19th August 2024 to allow new electrical connection to be installed

Open Space

(1)The Parish Council discussed the offer of a donated memorial seat by the South Cave Show Committee. It was noted the preferred location to be Little Wold Lane, the suggestion was for the seat to b a ‘Happy to Chat Seat’ in memory of resident. It was noted a memorial seat in disrepair at Little Wold Lane may be considered for replacement, subject to the agreement by both parties to include two memorial plaques. In the event of South Cave show committee being unhappy with the suggestion, Queen Elizabeth II field was identified as being a suitable location for a two seater Marmax seat.
