**OSC 615 – Apologies for Absence**

Cllr Barnett proposed that apologies be accepted from Cllr Turner, Seconded Cllr Foley, All in favour

**OSC 616 – Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest

**OSC 617– King George V Playing Field**

(1)The Parish Council consider future plan for additional Sports and children’s Play equipment – King George V field including sensory items, It was noted discussions were in place with funding providers further details to follow

(2)The Committee noted the ROSPA inspection was due, inspection to be received at a later date

(3)The Committee considered tree works and price received from Tree Engineers. Cllr Edmond proposed the Parish Council proceed with the work including the removal of split conifer hedge limb and crown lifting of two Trees to allow Maintenance works. Seconded Cllr Long, All in favour

**OSC 618 – Playpark**

(1)The Committee considered playpark path improvements and requested further details relating to the associates costs received

(2) The Committee noted the ROSPA inspection was due, inspection to be received at a later date

**OSC 619 – Cemetery**

(1)The Committee discussed Cemetery vermin controls. Cllr Edmond proposed appropriate controls be arranged without the use of firearms. Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour

(2)The Committee received Price for Lych Gate repair/replacement and requested comparison quotes be obtained.

(3)The Committee considered the installation of memorial Tree to be donated by South Cave Show Committee. Cllr Edmond proposed a small Cherry Tree to be planted, location to be identified. Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

**OSC 620 – Allotments**

(1)The Committee received update relating to Humber Forest application & considered alternative arrangements for Boundary Fencing works. It was noted no response from ERYC relating to grant funding. Price requested for the installation of minimal boundary fence to be discussed at Full Council

**OSC 621 – Queen Elizabeth II**

(1)The Committee discussed the possibility of reading/learning area to open space & potential funding , it was noted a meeting had been arranged with the funding provider

**OSC 622 - Other Matters**

(1)The Committee Considered price received from GJ Landscapes 2025/26, with only a minimal increase in costs. Cllr Edmond proposed the Parish Council proceed with the acceptance of the costs for 2025/2026, seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour.
