TS 519 - Apologies

Cllr Barnett proposed that apologies be accepted from Cllr Turner, Seconded Cllr Bateman, All in favour

(1) There were no declarations of interest

TS 521 – Traffic, roads and footpaths

(1) The Committee received an update relating to ‘Community Speedwatch’ and requested a letter be sent to the Crime commissioner highlighting the importance of the role and replacement of a Community Speed watch co-Ordinator.

(2) The Committee received update relating to Community Sub-Committee Group – pedestrian safety & driver awareness, it was noted the sub-committee were working with the School and is a ongoing project

TS 522 – Festive Lights

(1) The Committee received update relating to Festive lighting with the switch on being arranged for Friday 29th November 2024

TS 523 – Town Hall

(1) The Committee Discussed the= Town Hall (date) stone and considered preservation precautions. Further contact with tradesman to be sought

TS 524 – Street Furniture

(1) The Committee discussed the maintenance of a memorial seat located at the top of Little Wold Lane. It was noted that some repairs had been made but the seat was still in a position of disrepair and should be considered for removal.

Cllr Foley proposed the Parish Council only install in the future, memorial seats which are low maintenance (recyclable plastic seats) and any memorial seats in a position of disrepair should be removed, the donator of the seat be made aware minimal maintenance will be completed and removal of any seat in disrepair is at the Parish Councils discretion. Seconded Cllr Rignall, All in favour

(2) The committee discussed seat restoration/Maintenance – Lifestyle seat and requested prices be obtained for general maintenance.

TS 525 – Other Matters

(1) The Committee consider the budget for an additional 6 hours per week footway cleaner/general maintenance duties commencing April 2025 – increasing weekly hours to 24 hours per week. Cllr Edmond proposed the Parish Council increase the hours as a requirement for the maintenance of the village, Seconded Cllr Barnett, All in favour
