Caves u3a's aim is to provide interesting things for older people to do in their free time.

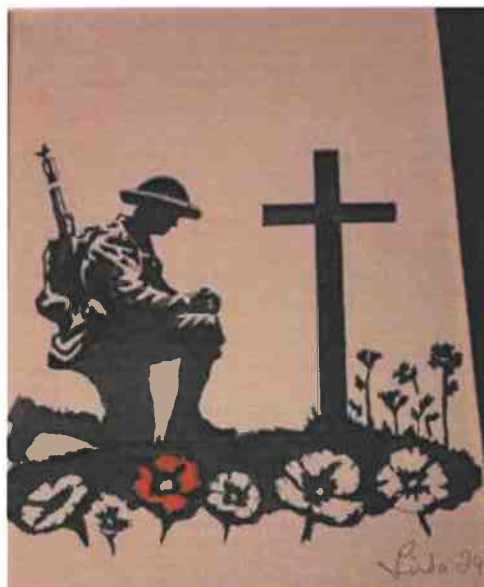
On Monday January 6th Keith Parsons will describe the life and work of the novelist and journalist Winifred Holtby.

Community Speed Watch Group Road traffic speed in South Cave is basically subjected to max speed limits of 40 or 30 MPH. The one exception being Church Street, near the South Cave Primary School, where a 20 MPH limit applies. These speed limits are in place to improve the safety of all road users, especially pedestrians. Does the excess speed of traffic through South Cave concern you? Have you made your concerns known to the Parish Council? If your answer is YES to the above, and you have some weekday free time during daylight hours, have you considered what YOU can do to improve the situation? The South Cave Speed Watch team is a small group of volunteers who in conjunction with Safer Roads Humber and Humberside Police, monitor, record, and feedback traffic speeds passing through South Cave. If you have a couple of spare hours and wish to improve the road safety of the area, why not register your interest with The South Cave Parish who will put you in touch with the Community Speedwatch co-ordinator

Flood Warden Volunteer

The East Riding of Yorkshire Council is planning to implement a local Flood Warden for the village. Following the extremely wet winter season last year, the Council has identified several locations that could benefit from the presence of local flood wardens. These wardens would serve as 'eyes on the ground' and act as a reliable source of information for the Council. Sout Cave Parish been identified as one of the key areas.

The responsibilities of the flood wardens will include:

- Championing flood resilience within the community.
- Monitoring watercourse levels and reporting when they exceed predetermined trigger points.
- Activating flip-down signs to alert motorists of water on the highway when necessary.

The flood wardens will be provided with comprehensive training and personal protective equipment (PPE) as part of their volunteer role.

When there is no flood warning in place:

- Raise awareness of flooding issues within the local community.
- Report issues such as blockages of bridges or damage to flood defences to the relevant agency.
- Encourage local residents to register for the free flood warning service from the Environment Agency.
- Ensure people are aware of Floodline and know their quick dial code.
- Promote self-help within the community.
- Attend town or parish council and/or other local meetings to ensure flooding issues retain a high profile.
- Collaborate with their town or parish council to develop a flood plan aimed at mitigating the effects of flooding.

During a flooding event:

- Keep the Highways duty officer informed of river levels when they reach trigger points.
- Inform the Town or Parish Council of the situation and encourage them to take appropriate action.
- Help identify and support the most vulnerable individuals in their community.
- Cooperate with the local authority and emergency services.
- Deploy flood signs if flooding is expected on the highway.
- Maintain a log of events and actions taken.
- Take photographs of flooding to be used in post-event reports.
- Report flooding or issues such as blockages likely to lead to flooding.
