Report received from Ward Cllr Terry Gill in his absence:
Fly tipping top of Swainscaife Road where it meets the Wold Way path. I have been liaising with the landowners who have finally removed the commercial waste that was dumped there.

As I am sure you are aware this road has a history of fly tipping, which is harmful to wildlife and alike. I am also suggesting to the land owners to install some deterrents like signs cameras etc.

There is also. Report of general fly waste on Beverley Road passed the Vinyard entrance and a couple of other spots on the way to Walkington. I am currently checking this out and will liaise with whoever is responsible.

Not sure if you are aware but there will be a road closure on Beverley Rd outside No: 69 from 8am 17th Feb till 6pm 19th Feb. Access will be maintained for Emergency vehicles, Pedestrians and residents.

The reason for the works is an underground electrical connection.
