An update from ERYC was provided in relating to the two streetlights at Church Street South Cave. It was noted Northern Powergrid were to repair a fault on the line.
Councillor Thornham raised a query relating to Bins being placed on Footpaths at Church Street (on the day of collection) leaving pedestrians to walk on the Highway. Further information was requested on the matter for the Parish Council to make comment.
It was noted the ERYC Precept Tax Base had been confirmed.
Bellway Homes Footpath – Residents were enquiring the possibility of Bellway homes installing solar lighting to the fencing to assist with users of the footpath
