**TS 532 - Apologies**

Cllr Barnett proposed that apologies be accepted from Cllr Bateman, Seconded Cllr Turner, All in favour

**TS 533 - Declaration of Interests**

(1) There were no declarations of interest

**TS 534 – Traffic, roads and footpaths**

(1) The Committee received update relating to ‘Community Speedwatch’ , it was noted a meeting was to be held Monday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2025 which will provide speedwatch members with further information on the new training requirements. It was also noted the Community Speedwatch coordinator would be happy to attend the Annual Parish Meeting to provide the public with a overview of work.

(2) The Committee considered the SIDS grant application and received information relating the continued maintenance costs. It was suggested a zebra crossing be considered and requested at Church Street (school) due to the lack of pedestrian crossing patrol and the potential increase in numbers of users following the growth of South Cave developments. Cllr Barnett proposed the Parish Council contact the School and PTA to consider support and make arrangements for a site meeting to discuss Pedestrian Safety with ERYC Highways Officers. Seconded Cllr Foley, All in favor

**TS 535 – Festive Lights**

(1) The Committee noted the update relating to Festive lighting, with two minor issues arising relating to tree installations.

**TS 536 – Town Hall**

(1) The Committee discussed Town Hall (date) stone and consider preservation precautions, it was noted a price had been received and a grant application had been submitted

**TS 537 – Street Furniture**

(1) It was noted the arrangements to remove the memorial seat located at Little Wold Lane had been arranged with the plaque being returned to the owner

(2) It was noted a offer of donation for the replacement of the Lifestyle seat at Bull Pasture due to the current Lifestyle Seat being in disrepair. Cllr Edmond proposed the Parish Council relocated the current lifestyle plaque onto the seat which is currently not in disrepair, allowing the space for a new Marmax memorial seat to be installed in memory of Mr Roberts.
