(3) The Parish Council considered an increase in the hourly payment rate for the supply of Footway Cleaning Services contracted by Nicholas Associates Group. The Parish Council approved an increase of £1.19 per hour for the footway cleaner, in line with comparable roles within ERYC. It was noted that Nicholas Associates Group remains the primary employer and is responsible for the management of PAYE, holiday entitlement, sickness, and National Insurance contributions.
